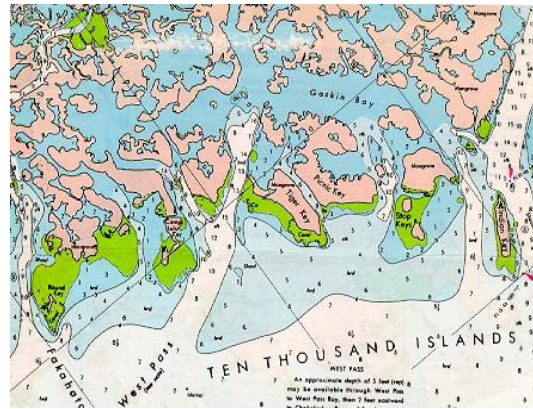




Presents: "10,000 Islands Pontoon Nature Excursion"

Navigate through the wild and winding 10,000 Islands National Wildlife Refuge in search of playful dolphins, curious Brown Pelicans and foraging seabirds. Departing from the Port of the Islands Marina, we will begin a breathtaking narrated-cruise through a manatee sanctuary on our way toward the Gulf of Mexico. Witness the teeming natural realm of Florida's mangrove islands, home to thousands of species of the air, land and sea; creatures that use the mangrove's protective cover during the formative periods of their life cycle. It is here that the Spiny Lobster spends the first two years of its life before heading to the open waters offshore.



After exploring the various channels of the 10,000 Islands, we will encounter uninhabited Panther Island, a barrier key with glistening white sand beaches and natural vistas for as far as the eye can see. From this vantage point we are looking out into the beautiful Gulf of Mexico and with only the hint of far-off civilization, this place looks as it would have when the first settlers arrived centuries ago.
