Enthused by the 19th century cargo and passenger schooners of legend, the Heritage of Miami’s owner navigates this red-sailed beauty through the same waters that brought the first settlers to South Florida’s shores. Pausing to consider this thought gives credence to the local’s oft-quoted reminder, “We all came by water.”
